"A hockey skill development program offered within a public or private academic institution for any student registered or wanting to become registered with a minor hockey association team."

The Canadian Hockey Skills Academy initiative is a result of the "1999 Molson Open Ice Summit."

The concept allows local school boards the opportunity to work together with Minor Hockey Associations and Hockey Canada to offer hockey as an academic option to any student wishing to participate in the program.

The Role of the Hockey Canada Skills Academy

- 1. To provide additional skills training for minor hockey aged players
- 2. To supplement, not compete with, the existing programs run by Minor Hockey Associations
- 3. To provide emphasis on individual skill development and academic achievement
- 4. To create an environment for skill development which will enhance game performance
