Program Levels



- All programs have 2 levels (A & B)
- Esthetics and Hairstyling have a 3rd level (C)
- Culinary Arts has an optional level C focused on baking
- You may start RRTVA programming in Grade 10, but it is also possible to complete a program if you start in Grade 11 or 12
- You may have the option to complete one level of a program in the fall semester after you graduate at no charge to you

General Information




- RRTVA programs include students from 5 different school divisions
- Programs require an application and limited spaces are available
- Programs take a full semester
- The opposite semester will be used for compulsory courses



- Programs begin at 9:30 am and end around 2:30 pm
- You can not choose which semester you are scheduled to take RRTVA



- RRTVA programs allow you to earn 4 credits over the semester
- Credits will count as elective courses and may be at the 20/30/40S level
- Grade 10 students will not have room in their schedule for additional elective courses.



- You will be back at school in time for bussing home
- If your program is at a different site, buses depart at 9:00 am and return around 3:15pm
- If you already have a long bus ride to and from school, you may want to consider the location of your program and how much bus time that adds to your day.

RRTVA: How it is different

Connection to HSAP

- High School Apprenticeship
 Program (HSAP) allows students in
 high school the opportunity to
 explore and pursue trades training
- HSAP courses allow students to build hours toward certification

Marking will be different

- Average of 70% and above means a student is eligible to earn Apprentice Level 1 certification
- Teachers will grade in such a way that only students who are able to meet certification standards earn the 70% average
- Students can still earn credits without reaching certification standards (average of between 50%-70%)

Regular attendance is extremely important

- Courses taught in blocks, one at a time.
- Missing one day is equivalent to missing four classes.
- Missing multiple weeks can lead to loss of a credit, which means that certification is not possible.




Steps to Apply

- Pick up an RRTVA application form
- Discuss the options with your parents
- Complete the RRTVA application and have your parent/guardian sign it
 - You may indicate a first choice (1) and a second choice (2)
- Enter the RRTVA course codes onto your WCMC course selection form
- Enter all of your course selections, RRTVA and other courses, into PowerSchool.
 - The individual RRTVA programs are not listed in PowerSchool
 - RRTVA Level A is available as an alternate course selection
 - o RRTVA Level B and C are available as elective course selections
- Hand your application and completed course selection form into the office by MARCH 18th
- Health Care Aide has a different process, and you can only apply if you are currently in grade 11 or 12. See Ms. Tonna for more details



What if I change my mind?



- There are only a small number of seats in a program available to W.C. Miller students, sometimes only one.
- If you ask to switch programs after the March 18 deadline, you will only be considered after the students who have already applied.
- If you decide to take regular classes instead of RRTVA after your schedule is created, you are very unlikely to get into all of the courses you request.
- If you are signing up with a friend, you may not both get into the program. Consider whether you are willing to take the program alone or not.

Distributing Spots



When we have more applications than spots available in a program, we will look at each of the following factors:

- Grade level of applicant Grade 11 given top preference, then Grade 10, then Grade 12
- Experience in the trade
- School attendance
- Success in coursework related to trade ex: Electrical courses require strong math skills

In some cases, applicants will be asked to fill out an additional application form to provide information on why they are interested and a description of their experience.

Final Reminders

- If your application is submitted after March 18, you will only be considered for programs AFTER the applications that come in on time.
- Handing your application in before March 18th does NOT mean you have a better chance of getting selected, so please don't rush. You are welcome to hand it in early if it is accurate and complete.
- RRTVA enrollment will be communicated on your school schedule which is shared in July.
