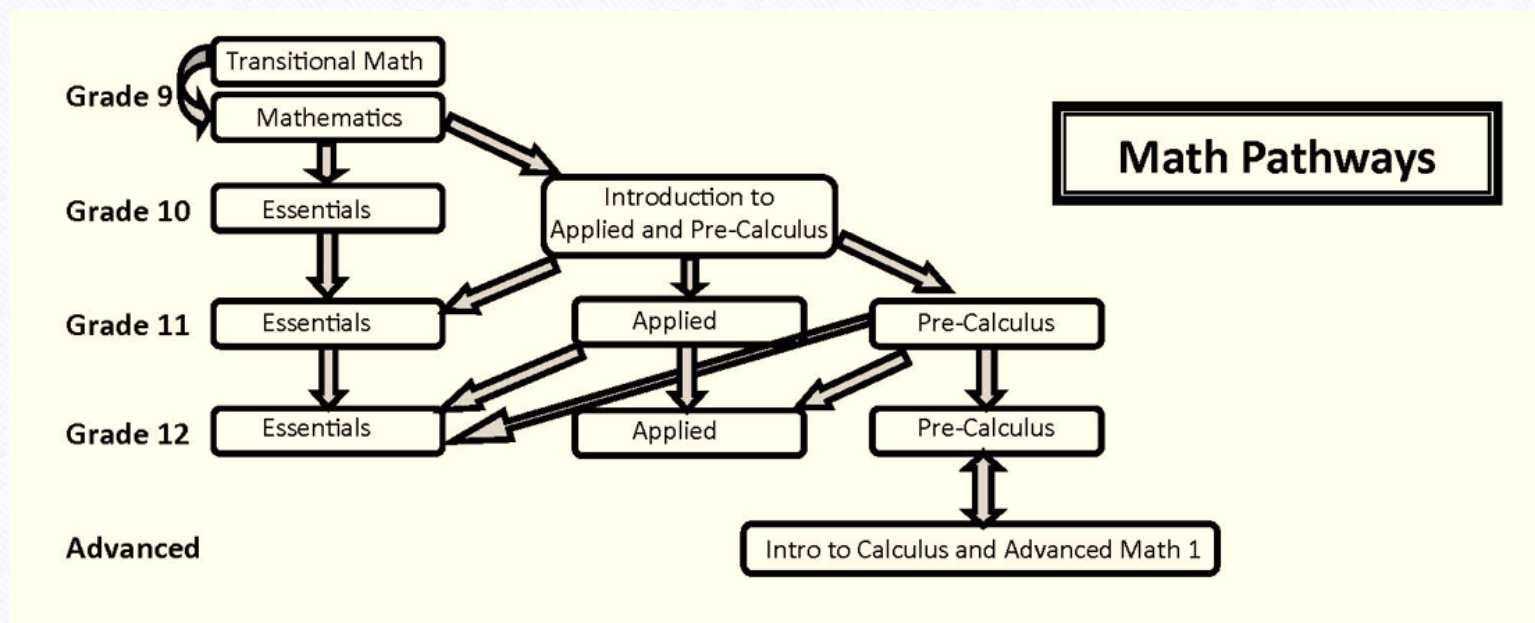

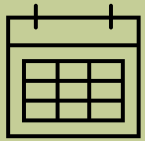

RRTVA – What You Should Know



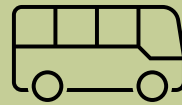
- RRTVA programs require an application
- Programs take a full semester
- **The opposite semester will be used for compulsory courses**



- Programs begin at 9:30 am and end around 2:30 pm
- You will be back at W.C.Miller in time for bussing home



- Most RRTVA programs allow you to earn 4 credits over the semester



- If your program is at a different site, buses leave W.C.Miller around 9:00 am and return around 3:15pm


